Dress Code:	Please dress as you would for school; the only exception is that you must wear closed-toed shoes for safety – no flip-flops or sandals of any kind.
Attendance:	Participants are expected to attend the OSMP workshop everyday for the two week period. If you cannot make a day or part of a day for any reason please contact Dan Gilbert or Chris Schaben immediately. We're aiming to make OSMP successful for all and will work through attendance issues on a case-by-case basis.
Parking:	Parking is available in the lot just North of the Student Life Center on 40 th and Jones Streets – map on reverse
Drop-off and Pick-up:	Students can be dropped off and picked up outside the Sorrell Center on Emile Street just east of 42 nd Street (map on reverse). An OSMP team member will be there by 7:30 every morning and will wait with students at the end of the day until parents arrive.
Cell phones:	Cell phones are okay to bring, but should be used only for emergencies or during our breaks.
Lunch:	All participants will receive a lunch voucher that can be used at the UNMC cafeteria. We will walk to and from the cafeteria as a group from the Sorrell Center.
Breaks and Snacks:	We will have a morning and an afternoon break every day for approximately 15 minutes. The project will provide some granola bars, drinks, fruit and/or other light snacks during this time. Participants can bring their own snacks as well. It is recommended that students bring money if they wish to purchase snacks or drinks from the convenience store or vending area located in the Sorrell Center.
Community Celebration and Viewing:	This event will be held from 2:00 – 4:00 pm on July 17 th at the Sorrell Center. The reception will be held in the 3 rd Floor Alumni Commons Area (the same location as the OSMP kick-off and pizza party) and the community viewing in the amphitheater (MSC 3002). Detailed information and invites will come home with the students during the workshop.
Transportation:	For those going to Lincoln, a professional driver from Arrow Stage Lines will drive a mini-coach style bus. For the Omaha teams, OPS teachers will drive OPS vans from the UNMC Sorrell Center to medical offices at 45 th and Center Streets and 52 nd and Leavenworth Streets.
Stipends:	As soon as we receive the students' Social Security Number (SSN), the UNL team will start the process of getting a check cut. It is our goal to have these all processed by the end of the workshop, however, there is a chance that the check will be mailed to you after the workshop.
