Dress Code:	Please dress as you would for school; the only exception is that you must wear closed -toed shoes for safety – no flip-flops or sandals of any kind .
Attendance:	Participants are expected to attend the OSMP workshop everyday for the two week period. If you cannot make a day or part of a day for any reason please contact Dan Gilbert or Chris Schaben immediately. We 're aiming to make OSMP successful for all and will work through attendance issues on a case -by-case basis.
Parking:	Parking is available in the lot just North of the Student Life Center on 40 th and Jones Streets – map on revers e
Drop-off and Pick-up:	Students can be dropped off and picked up outside the Sorrell Center on Emile Street just east o f 42 nd Street (map on reverse). An OSMP team member will be there by 7:30 every morning and will wait with students at the end of the day until parents arrive.
Cell phones:	Cell phones are okay to bring, but should be u sed only for emergencies or during our breaks.
Lunch:	All participants will receive a lunch voucher that can be used at the UNMC cafeteria. We will walk to and from the cafeteria as a group from the Sorrell Center.
Breaks and Snacks:	We will have a morning and an afternoon break everyd ay for approximately 15 minutes. The project will provide some granola bars, drinks, fruit and/or other light snacks during this time. Participants can bring their own snacks as well. It is recommended that students bring money if they wish to purchase s nacks or drinks from the convenience store or vending area located in the Sorrell Center.
Community Celebration and Viewing:	This event will be held from 2:00 – 4:00 pm on July 17 th at the Sorrell Center.
